HSC OP: 10.25, **TTUHSC President's Awards**

PURPOSE: The purpose of this HSC Operating Policy and Procedure (HSC OP) is to establish the

policy that governs the selection of recipients of the TTUHSC President's Awards.

REVIEW: This HSC OP will be reviewed on September 1 of every even-numbered year (ENY) by

the Academics Council and the Provost, with recommendations for revisions forwarded to

the President by November 1.

POLICY/PROCEDURE:

 General Policy. Seven award categories will be included: President's Excellence in Teaching Award, President's Team Teaching Award, President's Excellence in Research Award, President's Early Career Investigator Award, President's Outstanding Clinician Award, President's Excellence in Community Engagement Award, and President's Award for Interprofessional Collaborative Practice. These awards will be scored according to a rubric and presented in accordance with the following criteria:

- a. President's Excellence in Teaching Award. Recipients of this award will have sustained
 excellence in teaching at TTUHSC as demonstrated in student and peer evaluations and a
 strong commitment to the educational process, innovations, or originality in teaching.
