4. Reasonable Break Time

- a. Safekeeping of the expressed milk is the responsibility of the team member. All expressed milk must be stored in closed containers, regardless of the method of storage.
- b. If the expressed milk is stored in a common refrigerated space, the team member must provide an insulated container to avoid contamination from other items stored therein. The container should be labeled with the team member's name and the date.
- c. If a refrigerator is not available, the team member may bring a small ice chest or other insulated container to store their expressed milk.
