Healthcare in Turkey: A Journey To the Country Where the Continents Meet

Fatma Levent, MD was born and raised in Adana, Turkey. Dr. Levent attended Medical School at Cukurova University, Faculty of Medicine in Adana, Turkey. In 2000 she and her husband moved to the U.S. and she began her residency in Pediatrics at Texas Tech Health Sciences Center (TTUHSC) in 2003. After completing her residency, Dr. Levent moved to Houston to pursue a fellowship in Pediatric Infectious Diseases at Baylor College of Medicine. She returned to Lubbock and joined TTUHSC in 2009 as clinical faculty.

Dr. Levent returned to Turkey in 2012 due to family issues, including her mother's diagnosis of ovarian cancer. She lived in Turkey for two years and worked at Adana Numune Training and Research Hospital as a Pediatric Infectious Diseases specialist as a part of her Compulsory Health Service Program. She returned to TTUHSC as a faculty member in the Department of Pediatrics in July, 2014.

Dr. Levent's presentation will include a general approach to healthcare in Turkey with examples of her experiences as a Pediatric Infectious Diseases Specialist in Adana, Turkey.
