State of the World 2016: Predictions & Reflections featuring **Ambassador Tibor P. Nagy** **Vice Provost for International Affairs** **Texas Tech University**

In addition to his service abroad, Ambassador Nagy served as an Africa advisor to two presidential campaigns: Obama in 2008 and Romney in 2012. Over the years, Ambassador Nagy has lived or worked in Zambia, Seychelles, Ethiopia, Cameroon, Nigeria, and Guinea.
