General Services

Intake

Explores vocational history, as well as any barriers to employment.

Career Plan

Individuals learn about their vocational strengths and abilities and how to enter or rejoin the work force. Facilitation of career and interest exploration and labor market survey included. This service includes 2 sessions lasting 60 minutes each.

Career Focus

Provides up to three community employer visits/job shadowing experiences to define a career goal. Facilitation of career exploration and labor market survey included.

Career Specific Assessments

Options include:

- Labor Market Survey
- Learning Style Inventory
- Life Values SelfAssessment

Personal Social Adjustment Training(PSAT)

Includes individual assistance with understanding most recent diagnosis and how that relates to independent living, quality of life, and employment. Can be completed individually or in a group setting. Groups can be up to 5 people.
