Adhering to SoM Requirements for Fair and Timely Grade Assignment

Instructions for Clerkship Directors and Coordinators Approved: CEOGSeptember7, 2018

Background: LCME Element 9.8 states that medical school has in place a system of fair and timely summative assessment of medical student achievement in each course and clerkship of the medical education program. Final grades are available invisitix weeks of the end of a course or clerkship. Although the LCME requirement states that grades must be available in 6 weeks of the end of a clerkship, the SoM in SOMCOPO1: Grading Policytates that: "The Clerkship Director in each department is responsible for ensuring that grades are assigned in a timely manner. Grades should be submitted to the Office of Student Affairs within twomety(21) days

grading (in Examsoft) with the days of receipt of patient notes. Clerkship coordinators enter SP grades into Examsoft within 48 hours of receipt of responses.
