



The primary objectives of ACPE Standard 2016 are for pharmacy students to be ready for Advanced Pharmacy Practice Experience (APPE), practice, and patient care team contribution.

To develop a reliable assessment that evaluates pharmacy students' basic drug knowledge and readiness for progression to APPE.

A minimal competency High Risk Drug Knowledge Assessment (HRDKA) exam was developed to evaluate student basic knowledge of top 200 drugs (in-patient and out-patient) utilized in the APPE. The exam
