(Stating the sentiments of the TTUHSC Student Senate congratulating the TTUHSC School of Health Professions on its 40th anniversary of delivering holistic student-centered education and cultivating educational experiences in an interprofessional environment.)

WHEREAS, TTUHSC School of Health Professions was established in 1983, then known as the School of Allied Health, with Robert Cornesky, SCD, serving as the founding dean and 19 students in the inaugural class<sup>1</sup>; and,

WHEREAS, TTUHSC School of Health Professions provides a diverse and inclusive student-centered learning environment for over 1,900 students on four campuses: Amarillo, Lubbock, Midland, and Odessa, along with distance learning; and,

WHEREAS, TTUHSC School of Health Professions offers 21 bachelor, master, and doctorate degree programs and six graduate certificate options across five

WHEREAS, TTUHSC School of Health Professions offers competitive programs with a 93% licensure first-time pass rate that are ranked highly, such as the Occupational Therapy program ranking 23rd and four other programs in the top 100 in the United States<sup>2</sup>; and, therefore,
